

Kittitas County Joint Control Board No. 1
Board of Directors Meeting
May 5, 2026 Minutes

The Board of Directors of the Kittitas County Joint Control Board No. 1 (KCJB) met in Regular Session on May 5, 2026 at 12:30 p.m. Attending the meeting, were KCJB Chairman Mark Hansen, Director Arie Dyk, Director Tiffany Brain, Director Sherry Swanson, KRD Secretary Manager Urban Eberhart, KRD Assistant Manager Kevin Eslinger, KRD Field Supervisor Bob Main, Treasurer Mark Messner, Secretary Stacy Berg, and KRD Legal Counsel Jeff Slothower.

KCJB Chairman Hansen called the meeting to order. The agenda was approved with a motion made by Director Brain. A second was made by Director Dyk, the motion passed unanimously.

The minutes for the April 7, 2026, Board Meeting were approved with a motion made by Director Brain, the second was made by Director Dyk. The motion passed unanimously.

Public Comment: There was no public comment.

Water Master Report: Water Master Report: As of May 5, 2026 the five reservoirs were at 96% capacity which is 125.5% of average. Precipitation at the five reservoirs for May 1 to date is .45 inches or 35% of average and 5% of the months average. Precipitation for the water year to date is 231.75 inches, or 117% of average. The Upper Yakima Basin Snotel Sites are reporting 13% of average. The Lower Yakima Basin Snotel Sites are reporting 33% of average. There is currently 63 cfs running for Westside.

Maintenance Report: Maintenance crews are currently spraying the Westside Canal. There have been no unexpected maintenance issues that have come up so far this season.

Treasurers Report: The treasurer's report was presented for the April expenses and signatures. The voucher for expenses included check numbers 1053-1056 in the sum of \$11,148.96 which was approved with a motion made by Director Brain. A second was made by Director Dyk, the motion passed unanimously.

Review of Operations: There were no issues noted at this time.

Old Business: Director Swanson reported that staff and Jacobs Engineering met on April 23, 2026 to review the area of potential effect for cultural resources. The committee will meet with the Westside Board after 60% of the design has been completed.

New Business: There was no new business.

Other Business: All business having been concluded the meeting was adjourned.
