

**Kittitas County Joint Control Board No. 1**  
**Board of Directors Meeting**  
**April 7, 2026 Minutes**

The Board of Directors of the Kittitas County Joint Control Board No. 1 (KCJB) met in Regular Session on April 7, 2026 at 12:30 p.m. Attending the meeting, were KCJB Chairman Mark Hansen, Director Arie Dyk, Director Tiffany Brain, Director Sherry Swanson, KRD Secretary Manager Urban Eberhart, KRD Assistant Manager Kevin Eslinger, KRD Field Supervisor Bob Main, Treasurer Mark Messner, Secretary Stacy Berg, and KRD Legal Counsel Jeff Slothower.

KCJB Chairman Hansen called the meeting to order. The agenda was approved with a motion made by Director Brain. A second was made by Director Dyk, the motion passed unanimously.

The minutes for the March 3, 2026, Board Meeting were approved with a motion made by Director Brain, the second was made by Director Dyk. The motion passed unanimously.

Public Comment: There was no public comment.

Water Master Report: As of April 7, 2026 the five reservoirs were at 93% capacity which is 137.6% of average. Precipitation at the five reservoirs for April 1 to date is 1.19 inches or 43% of average and 8.7% of the months average. Precipitation for the water year is 224.09 inches, or 121% of average. The Upper Yakima Basin Snotel Sites are reporting 32% of average. The Lower Yakima Basin Snotel Sites are reporting 57% of average. The United States Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) River Operations Meeting is April 9, 2026.

Maintenance Report: Westside Canal is now operational and delivering water.

Treasurers Report: The treasurer's report was presented for the March expenses and signatures. The voucher for expenses included check numbers 1048-1052 in the sum of \$34,036.41 which was approved with a motion made by Director Brain. A second was made by Director Dyk, the motion passed unanimously.

Review of Operations: There were no issues noted at this time.

Old Business: Director Swanson reported that the design work is continuing as scheduled. Jacobs Engineering is preparing for the cultural and historic work at this

time. A request for funding was submitted to the State for construction work. Additional funding options are also being considered.

New Business: There was no new business.

Other Business: All business having been concluded the meeting was adjourned.
